

**MASS TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY
PUBLIC HEARINGS ON
DISCONTINUATION OF BUS ROUTE #14 UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN – FLINT SHUTTLE SERVICE
MONDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2018**

The Mass Transportation Authority (MTA) will hold two Public Hearings on October 15, 2018 for the purpose of taking public comment on proposed discontinuation of Bus Route #14 University of Michigan- Flint Shuttle Service. The public hearings will be held on Monday, October 15, 2018 at 12:00 noon and at 6:00 p.m. at the Mass Transportation Authority – Downtown Transfer Center, 615 Harrison Street, Flint, Michigan 48502.

The following proposed discontinuation of service includes:

- MTA will discontinue Bus Route #14 University of Michigan- Flint Shuttle Service. Students and residents of downtown Flint will continue to be served by alternate MTA bus routes, including Route #1 North Saginaw, Route #2 MLK, Route #5 Dupont, Route #6 Lewis Selby, Route #7 Franklin and all other routes that originate at the Downtown Transfer Center.

The proposed service discontinuation of Bus Route #14 University of Michigan-Flint Shuttle Service will be considered by the Mass Transportation Authority Board of Directors along with the comments received from the public. The MTA Board of Directors will make the final decision regarding service at the October Board meeting.
